# **UNDERSTANDING FOUNDATION RECOGNITION POINTS**

#### What are Foundation recognition points and how can I accumulate them?

Foundation recognition points are awarded to donors who contribute to The Rotary Foundation through the <u>Annual Fund</u> or <u>PolioPlus</u>, or who contribute to sponsorship of a Foundation grant. Donors receive one recognition point for every U.S. dollar contributed to these funds. Contributions to the <u>Endowment Fund</u> are not eligible.

Donors can transfer Foundation recognition points to others to help them qualify as a Paul Harris Fellow or Multiple Paul Harris Fellow. Foundation recognition points belong to the original donor until the donor's death, unless the points are transferred, or until the donor uses them (the surviving spouse of a Major Donor may also use the points).

#### How do I transfer Foundation recognition points?

A minimum of 100 Foundation recognition points must be transferred at a time, and you must complete and sign the <u>Recognition and Transfer Request</u>. The points may not be transferred from individuals to a club or district. Individual donors are the only ones authorized to transfer recognition points from their individual account. Club presidents are the only ones authorized to transfer recognition points from a club account. District governors are the only ones authorized to transfer recognition points from a district account.

#### Can Foundation recognition points of deceased Rotarians be transferred?

No. These points expire unless the deceased Rotarian was a <u>Major Donor</u>, in which case, the spouse/partner maintains control of the Foundation recognition points during his or her lifetime.

#### Can a business or organization become a Paul Harris Fellow?

No. Only individuals can become Paul Harris Fellows. However, businesses and organizations can receive a Certificate of Appreciation for contributions of \$1,000 or more, or transfers of 1,000 points or more.

#### Can a deceased person become a Paul Harris Fellow?

Yes. A donor can recognize a deceased individual by requesting a Memorial Paul Harris Fellow designation.

#### Do Foundation recognition points count toward Major Donor recognition?

No. Only cumulative personal outright contributions count toward Major Donor recognition.

#### How are Foundation recognition points tracked?

Your club and district leaders can view the online Club Recognition Summary, which includes the recognition amount, tally of recognition points, current Paul Harris Fellow level, and date that level was achieved.

Through your My Rotary account, you can view your personal contribution history, recognition amount, and available Foundation recognition points. You can request a copy of your Donor History Report from the Foundation at <u>rotarysupportcenter@rotary.org</u>.

# On the Club Recognition Summary, what is the difference between recognition amount and available Foundation recognition points?

Recognition amount reflects the total Paul Harris Fellow recognition you have accumulated through your personal contributions plus all recognition points you've been given by other individuals, clubs, or districts. Recognition points given to you don't count toward Major Donor recognition. The maximum amount that can be shown on the Club Recognition Summary report is 9,000; the "+" sign indicates that the actual amount exceeds the 9,000-point maximum.

Available Foundation recognition points reflects points you have accumulated through personal outright giving to the Foundation. All points listed can be transferred to other individuals for Paul Harris Fellow recognition.

#### Can clubs or districts accumulate Foundation recognition points?

Yes. Clubs can view their recognition points in the Club Recognition Summary.

Districts' Foundation recognition points are shown in the Donor History Report. Districts may request the report at <u>rotarysupportcenter@rotary.org</u>.

#### How can I use Foundation recognition points to increase giving to the Foundation?

Matching outright contributions with Foundation recognition points may help your club reach or even surpass its Annual Fund goal, as well as achieve 100% Paul Harris Fellow recognition.

To determine whether your club is close to achieving 100% Paul Harris Fellow status, review the recognition amounts of all Rotarians currently listed as active club members in the Club Recognition Summary.

To determine whether you're close to achieving your Annual Fund goal, review the Monthly Contribution Report.

#### What recognition opportunities are available with Foundation recognition points?

Paul Harris Fellow

Paul Harris Fellow recognition is extended to any individual who contributes, outright or cumulatively (or in whose name is contributed), \$1,000 or more to the Annual Fund or PolioPlus or as sponsorship of a portion of a Foundation grant. The recognition consists of a certificate and pin. In addition, <u>Paul Harris Fellow medallions</u> can be ordered at <u>shop.rotary.org</u>.

Certificate of Appreciation

A Certificate of Appreciation is given to a business or organization in whose name a donor contributes \$1,000 or more.

Multiple Paul Harris Fellow

Multiple Paul Harris Fellow recognition is extended at subsequent \$1,000 levels. Recognition consists of a pin with stones corresponding to the recipient's recognition amount

\$3,000 to 3,999.99 - two sapphires

- \$5,000 to 5,999.99 four sapphires

# Doug and Sally Kauffmann PolioPlus Challenge

Between October 1, 2021 and November 15, 2021, Doug and Sally Kauffman will match every gift of \$100 or more given to PolioPlus by individual Rotarians up to \$20,000 for the District.

The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation will match that money two more times. That way for every Rotarian that gives \$100 or more, each gift will be increased four times (example Rotarian contributes \$100 for PolioPlus, Doug and Sally will contribute \$100 to PolioPlus, and Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation will contribute \$200 to PolioPlus).

Every Rotarian who gives \$100 or more will also receive that many Rotary Foundation Recognition Points. If you make that contribution online or over the phone with the Rotary Support Center 866-976-8279, you will double your Recognition Points up to a maximum of 600 points (example: a Rotarian contributes \$100 to PolioPlus through their club, they get 100 points, but if they contribute \$100 to PolioPlus online, they get 200 points).

Note: Anyone with a PHF+8 or a Major Donor will not be awarded points, but your contributions will be greatly appreciated! Recognition Points are of no value to these donors.

## How to Become a Paul Harris Fellow?

A Paul Harris Fellow can be earned by contributing \$1,000 over time to The Rotary Foundation to AF-SHARE or PolioPlus Fund. Current dollars/points toward PHF \_\_\_\_\_

## Is there another way to become a Paul Harris Fellow?

A person can be awarded a Paul Harris Fellow by doing something in the community that is noteworthy. This could person could be a Rotarian or non-Rotarian. This is typically done by using points or club dollars.

Also, some Rotarians will honor their spouse, children, grand-children, friends, etc. with a Paul Harris Fellow. This is typically done by using their points.

# **Emerald City Rotary Club - Points for Service**

The Emerald City Rotary club has a special program for new members. New members can earn up to 900 points by engaging in the community and learning more about Rotary.

\_\_\_\_\_ Contribute \$100 to The Rotary Foundation (**required**) with the pledge of continuing to contribute a minimum of \$100 a year.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points - Match for \$100 contribution

\_\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Attend orientation, logon to DaCdb and update online profile, logon to My Rotary and update profile, learn to view Donor History Report, and learn how to make an online contribution to The Rotary Foundation.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Participates in a committee within the club and/or participates in a club project.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Golf Tournament - Participate in the planning, securing sponsors, and volunteering the day of the tournament or playing in the tournament.

\_\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Rotary Natural Playground at Grace Street Park – Participate in the playground project by helping out during our working days. Also, can earn up to 200 points by visiting the park and checking out the Playground and Peace Pole (in sensory garden).

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Rise Against Hunger – Participate in Rise Against Hunger event. This can be a community sponsored event or Rotary sponsored event. You can get points for two events for a total of 200 points. (January – Joint Project with Greenwood and Emerald City Clubs)

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Josh the Otter – Participate in a Josh the Otter presentation by either reading the book, wearing the costume, or passing out the books.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Rotary Has Heart – Participate in collecting food, packaging the bags, and delivering to children. (January - February)

\_\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Rotary Field – Attend a Baseball (Rotary Field at YMCA) or Football (Field at Greenwood Christian) game with a Rotary shirt on. Before going learn the history of the field. See if another club member will go with you.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Visit with Other Rotarians – Participate as a volunteer or participate in the event of another club's project or fundraiser.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Attend a Rotary social. This could be one of the Festivals in Greenwood and visiting other club members.

\_\_\_\_\_ 100 points – Board Meeting or Visit another Club – Participate in a Board meeting for our club or attend a meeting for another club.

100 points – Rotary Leadership Institute – Part I – Participate in Rotary Leadership Institute I, which is at full day session. Cost is \$95 in-person or \$35 virtual paid by the club.

100 points – Rotary Leadership Institute – Part II – Participate in Rotary Leadership Institute II, which is a full day session. Cost is \$95 in-person or \$35 virtual paid by the club.

100 points – Rotary Leadership Institute – Part III – Participate in Rotary Leadership Institute III, which is a full day session. Cost is \$95 in-person or \$35 virtual paid by the club.
